Final Trim and steps (continued) :

18a/b) The last pieces of trim to add are the small decorative trim on top of the tower. These are fragile so take care when handling the kit from here on in.

Construct the back side steps as you did the front steps, starting by gluing the two riser sections into the slots on the wall then adding the peel-and-stick treads and landing.

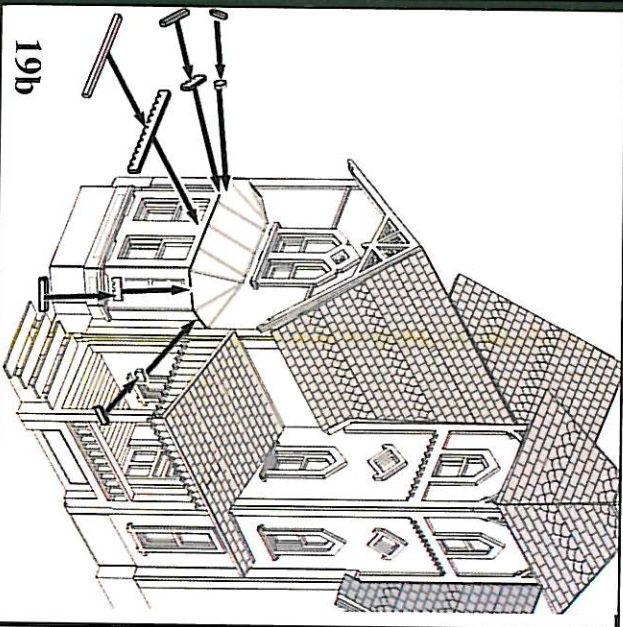
Bay Window Roof:

19a/b) Sand the back of the resin roof section flat as needed, then glue it to the top of the bay as shown using contact cement or epoxy. Once in place apply the upper trim sections to the bay walls keeping the top edges flush against the bottom of the roof.

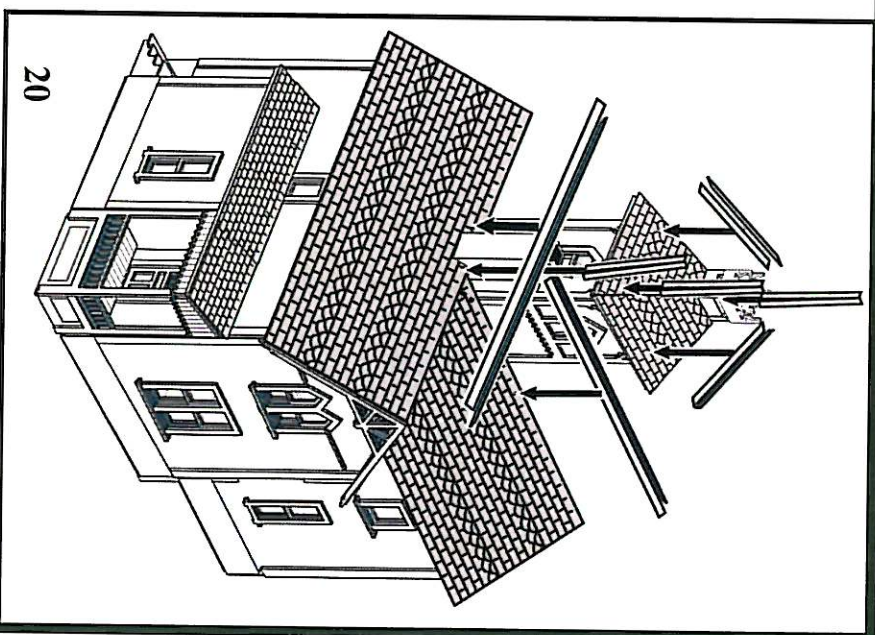
Final roof details:

20) Glue strips of roofing paper along each of the ridges to represent flashing or roof caps. Once dry paint the roofing your choice of colors. The scalloped singles can be picked out in a contrasting color if desired. The bay roof can be painted copper or green to represent an aged copper clad roof.
