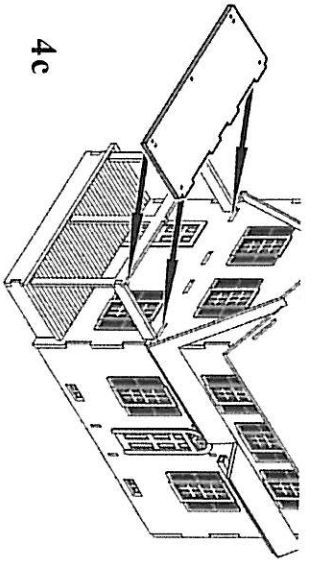

4C) Glue the porch roof panel into the house and onto the tabs on the top of the porch uprights.

4D) To complete the porch glue the decorative railings into place starting with the two side sections followed by the front. These glue into the holes in the roof.

Foundation:

5) Install the peel-and-stick stonework by removing the backing from each section and pressing it into place on the bottom edges of the walls. Note that each piece is cut to size to fit its area on the house. The larger pieces will overlap the smaller sections at the corners to give you a finished appearance.

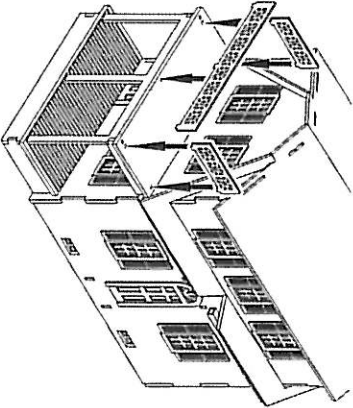
Once in place you can paint the stonework with a gray or brown paint. Spend a few minutes and pick out some of the individual stones with lighter and darker shades of your base color. Once this is dry follow with a wash of light gray or black to represent the mortar between the stones (Light gray will make the foundation appear newer, black older). Finally dry brush some light gray or tan highlights into the stones.

Rear porch:

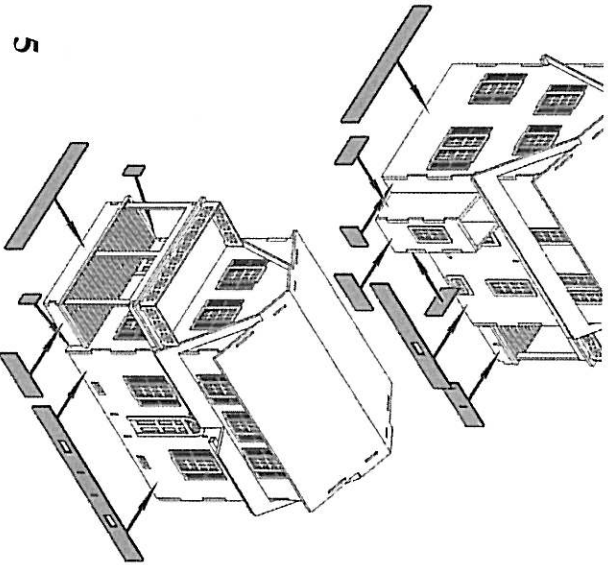
6A) Glue the flooring section into the slots in the rear wall. Next, glue the under floor support/stair and the railing into place as shown. The small roof support can be glued into the hole in the upper back wall. The larger railing section will glue into the 3 tabs on the side of the flooring piece.

6B) Now glue down the porch roof into place on top of the porch.

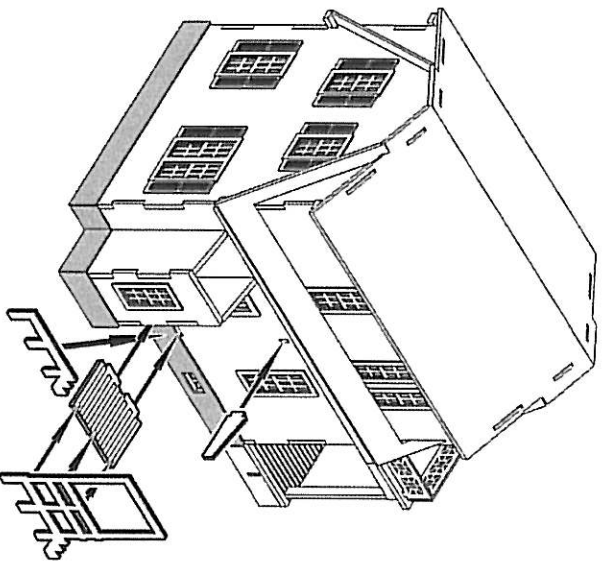
