Roof Seam caps and Chimney:

10A) Plastic striping is included in the kit and is used as roof caps. Cut to size and glue into place with plastic cement along the top peaks, inner edges and any other seam that may need covering of the roof panels. This trim can be painted the same as the roofing shingles and weathered accordingly. (See diagram for placement of the trim pieces).

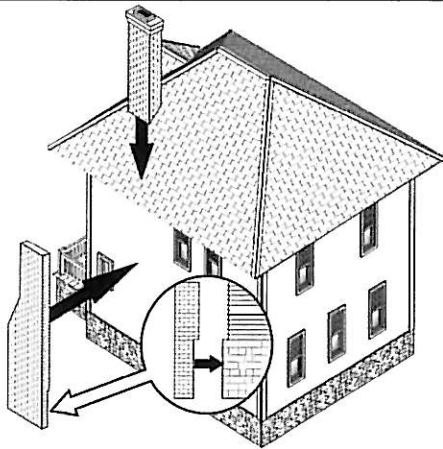
10B) A two piece resin chimney has been supplied with your kit. You may want to paint your chimneys before installation. Once dry, glue the larger side chimney to the side of the house between the two smaller windows. Note that it is notched at the bottom to fit over the foundation piece. The upper piece is located on top of the roofing, directly above the side one, giving the look of one continuous chimney. It can be installed by either cutting a hole through the roof and placing the chimney inside the opening or by sanding the bottom of the chimney to the proper angle and attaching it to the roof with cement. Use any extra plastic strips from your roof to trim out the bottom edges of the chimney as well.
