Foundation:

3) The peel and stick stone foundation sections should be installed doing the side pieces first, followed by the front and rear pieces. The front and rear pieces will overlap the side sections to give you a nice clean corner. The openings in the front wall should fit around the basement windows, giving them a recessed look.

Paint the stonework with a gray or brown paint. Spend a few minutes and pick out some of the individual stones with lighter and darker shades of your base color. Once this is dry follow with a wash of light gray or black to represent the mortar between the stones (Light gray will make the foundation appear newer, black older). Finally dry brush on some light gray or tan highlights.

Trim:

4) Apply the trim one corner at a time. Each corner consists of a wide and narrow piece. Apply the narrow section first, flush with the edge of the wall. Now apply the wider trim section so that it overlaps the edge of the narrower piece to form an even corner.

Subroofing:

5) The two sub roof panels for the rear of the house glue to the tabs on the wall tops. Once the two back sections are in place, add the front and rear main sub roof panels.

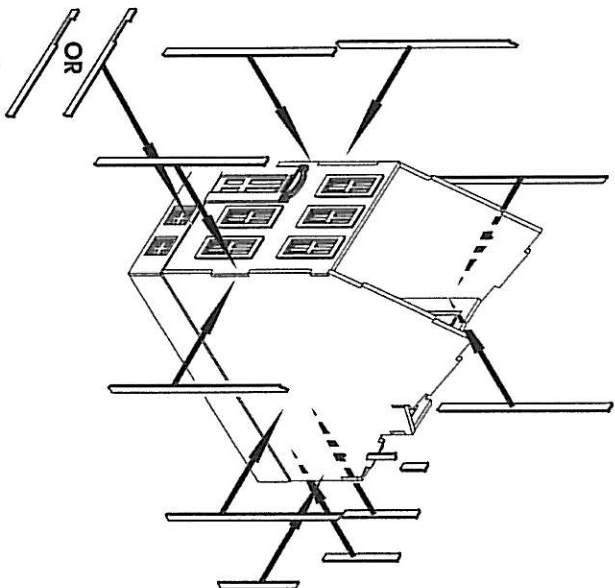
Extra add on options:

Decide which (if any) of the optional rear assemblies that you want to add to your kit, then refer to the appropriate directions below.

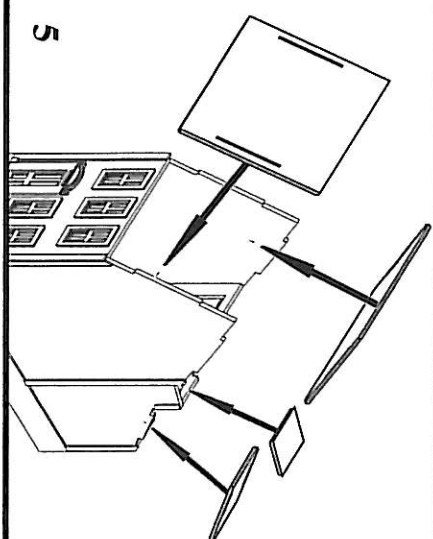
Rear room addition:

6A) Assembling the three wall sections as shown. Install the rear door and apply it to the addition instead of the original.

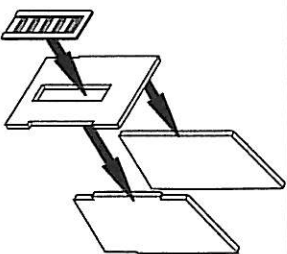
6B) Glue the completed addition to the side of the house. Note that the bottoms have been notched to fit over the foundation pieces.



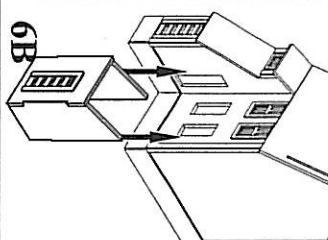

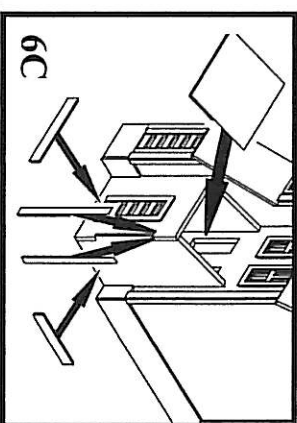

6C) Apply the two extra foundation pieces to your addition followed by the side trim and upper sub roof. You may want to paint the foundation a slightly different color or use less weathering than you did on the main foundation so that it looks like a newer addition. You could also weather the main house walls but leave the paint on the addition pristine to achieve the same effect. Be creative....
