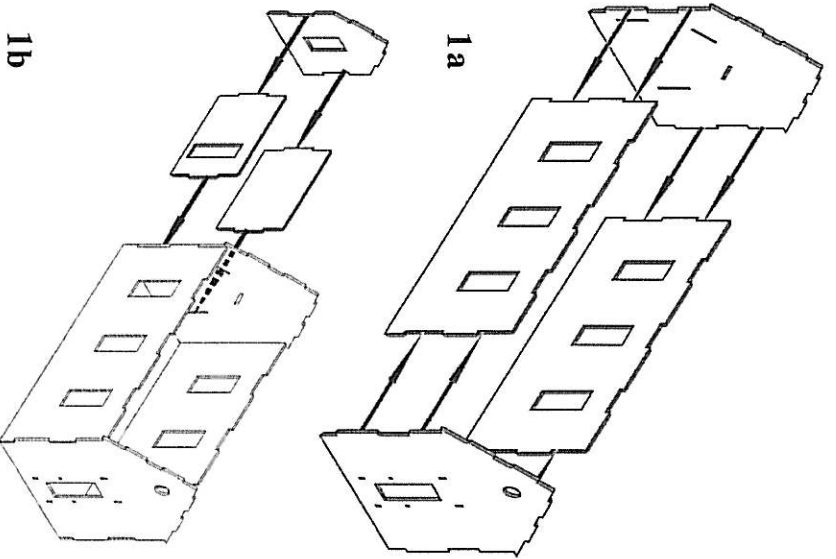


Constructing the shell:

1A) Start construction by assembling the main walls. Take the front wall assembly and glue each side wall section into place as shown. Now glue gluing the rear wall into place. Check that all of the corners are square and set aside to dry.

1B) Now glue the extension side walls into the rear wall, then glue the rear into place.



Windows:

2) To assemble the windows remove the peel-and-stick from the lower sash and apply a section of clear window glazing to it. Repeat with the upper sash and frame it being sure to keep the edge of the glazing flush with the top edge of the window. Now stick the lower sash into place on the frame. Note that it is possible to position the lower sash in an open position. Now take the window frame and remove the peel-and-stick from it. Center the window sash assembly into the frame and press into place. Finally, insert the window into the appropriate opening and press into place. The peel-and-stick on the frame will be more than enough to hold them into place.

Front and rear doors:

2) Remove the peel-and-stick from the outer door panel and apply it to the inner door panel. Now apply the door frame to the outside of the door and insert the complete door into the opening.

Foundation:

3) Remove the backing from each section of the stone foundation sheet - Starting with the side pieces, press each section into place on the bottom of the walls overlapping at the corners. See diagrams for placement.

The stone can now be painted. Take a few minutes and pick out a few of the stones in a lighter or darker shade of your base color, then add a wash of black or light gray for mortar.
