

Picnic tables:
 7) To construct the picnic tables start by gluing the center support brace to the two ends of the table legs. Glue the table top and benches onto the frames as shown. The completed tables can then be glued to the platform between the three posts.

Sign Boards:
 8) All of the paper signs (except the yellow menu) can be applied to the sign boards with white before the signs are installed on the building. Remove the backing from the sign boards and apply them to the stand as shown.
 The menu can simply be glued to the siding along side of the main window as shown.

Inner flooring and interior pieces:

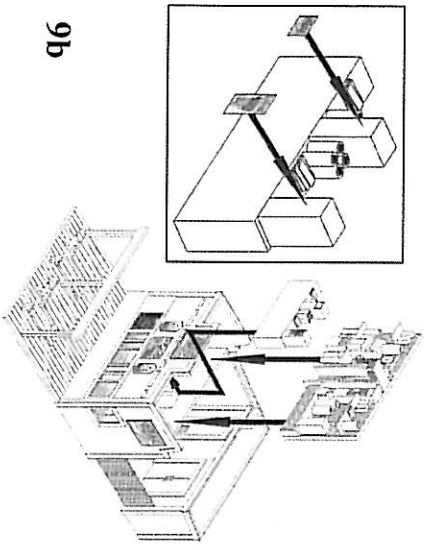
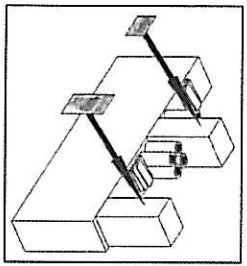
9A) Glue the printed floor into the interior of the kitchen as shown using a thin film of white glue.
 9B) There are two resin castings included in your kit to represent the serving counter and cooking area. Paint these with your choice of colors before they are installed. Take a few extra minutes and pick out some of the details in contrasting colors for some extra punch. Add the two small signs to the soda machine and the popcorn machine on the front counter after they are painted.

Cement the cooking area into place on the back wall. Cement the front counter into place below the front window.

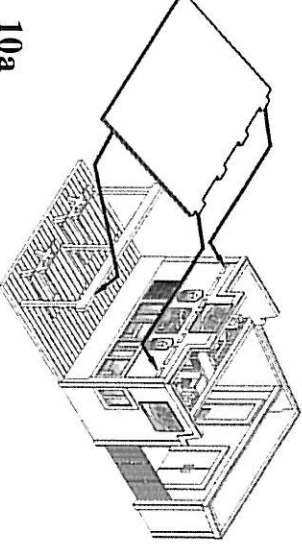
Sub Roof:

10A) Install the deck sub roof panel by gluing it into the slots on the front wall and to the roof support columns. Due to the angle of the roof panel you will notice a small gap where the roof meets the front wall. This will be covered over with the roof shingles later.

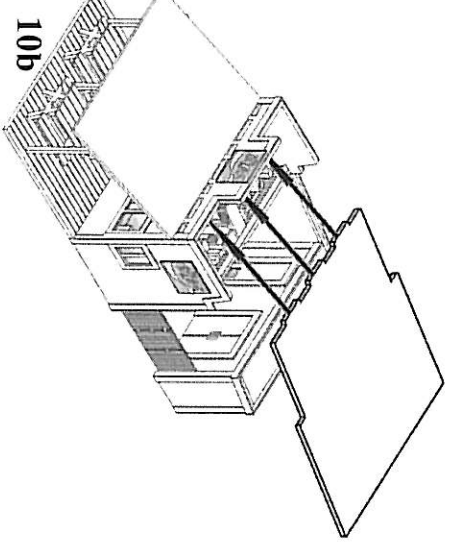
10B) The rear sub roof panel is designed to be removable to show off that wonderful interior you just painted! To install it, simply slide the tabs into the slots on the front wall and rest in place.
