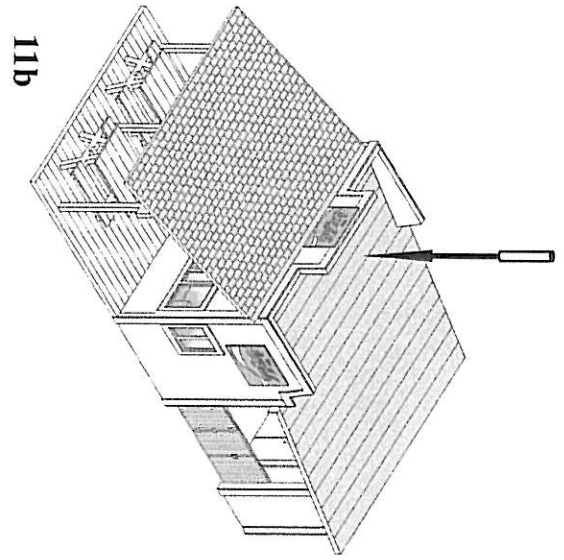
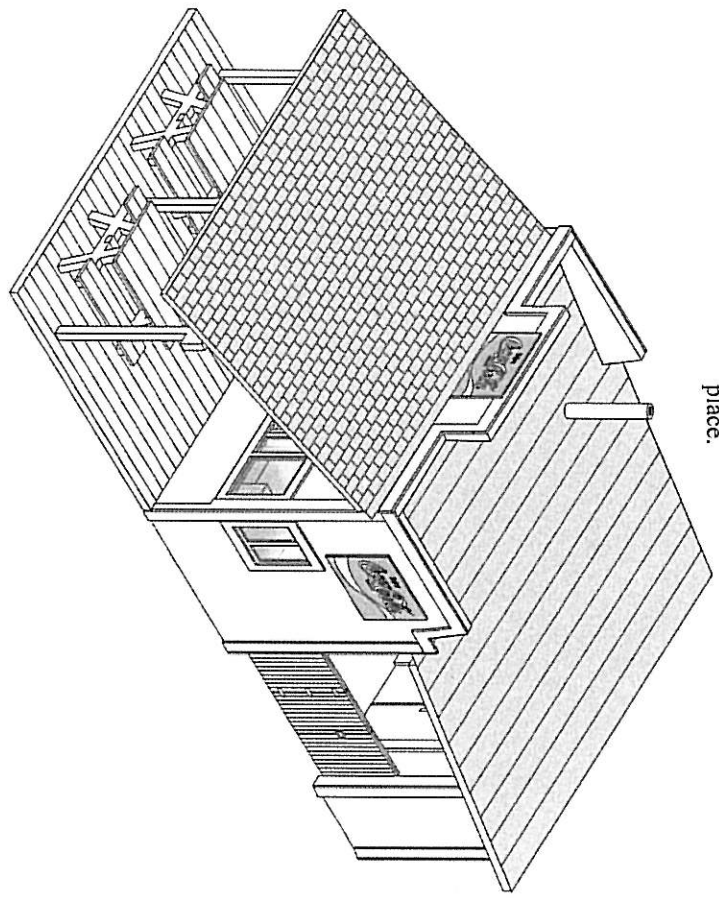


Roofing:

11A) Beginning at the bottom of each roof edge, glue down each strip of roof paper, overlapping them as you go up.

Add the paper roofing using white glue. On our model, the front area was done with the regular roof shingles and the back section was finished with the tar paper strip roofing, but you can use tar paper on the whole kit should you choose to. Stagger the perforations as you do each strip. This will give you the illusion of roof shingles. See illustrations for assistance. Roofing can be dry brushed in different colors for a weathering effect. We have found it is easier to weather your paper strips while still on the main sheet.

11B) A styrene tube is included to be used as a stove pipe. Drill a small hole into the roof where you want the stove pipe and glue the tube into place.



Your kit is now completed and ready for your layout. We hope you've enjoyed this kit.
