



**Ticket booth:**

3A) Glue the two ticket booth inner side walls into the slots in the front theater wall, then glue the front inner wall into place.

3B) Remove the backing from the wall panels and apply the window glazing to the centers of each panel as shown. Now apply the two side wall panels to the booth, then add the front panel. Note that the front panel should overlap the sides to create a clean corner.

3C) Remove the backing from the side trim panels and apply over the side walls you just installed, then install the front trim panel. Now install the additional horizontal trim pieces to the top of the booth as shown. These should be flush with the top edge of the booth walls.

**Trim:**

4) Apply the peel and stick corner trim starting with smaller width boards, applying them to each side wall with their edges flush with the corner. Now apply the larger width boards to each corner so that they overlap the others, giving you a nice clean corner. Note that the two taller sets of trim go on the front of the theater, the shorter sections go on the back. Install the two sections of trim into the opening in the front wall, starting with the wider piece first, to create the upper sign.

**Marquee Sign:**

5A) Glue the two marquee side panels to the front panel and to the flat roof as shown. Glue the completed assembly into the slots in the front wall.
