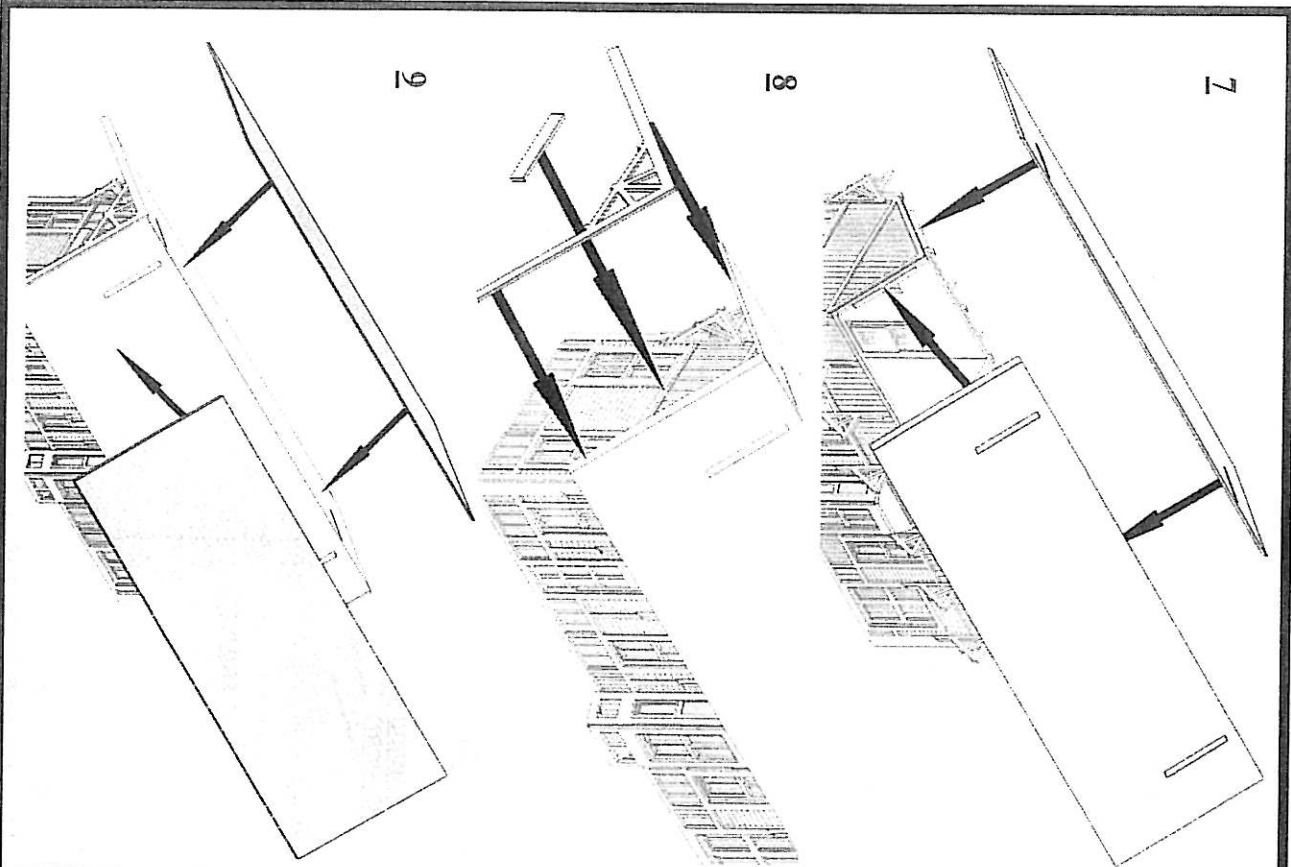


LASER-ART STRUCTURES by BRANCHLINE TRAINS



Sub roofing panels:

7) There are two sections of sub roofing for this kit. Note that one has a slightly wider side overhang than the other. This one will be placed on the side of the station without the bay window. Glue the sub roofing into place, locating it by using the tabs on the end walls. Make sure the scribed sides are facing downward.

Roof Trim and Sign Board:

8) You can now glue on the two decorative roof end trim boards. Note that the trim boards are asymmetrical. Make sure the long sides line up with the extended roof panel as mentioned above. The peel and stick sign boards locate on each end of the station, just above the two windows.

We have included a station sign for Cannondale and some vintage New Haven RR posters to dress up the station.

Roofing shingles:

9) Match each roof shingle panel to its appropriate sub roof section, then apply by removing the peel-and-stick backing and pressing them into place. Make sure they meet cleanly at the center roof peak.

Chimney and Roof cap:

10) A strip of styrene has been included to be used as a roof cap. Glue this into place with plastic cement. Now add the resin chimney. This should be sanded to match the roof angle and cemented into place using ACC or epoxy.
