For some added detail you can pick out individual shingles with slightly lighter or darker shades of the base color. Finally, add a thin wash of black and once this is dry brush the shingles with some vertical streaks of a lighter color to pick out the highlights.
 Paint your roof now. Many Santa Fe stations had red single roofs. You can also add some dry brushed highlights to help pick out the shingles.

Chimneys and vent pipes:

9) The two styrene tubes are for use as vent pipes. These can be added by drilling a small hole in the roof and inserting the tube, cemented it from the inside. Now add the main chimneys. The chimneys can either be sanded to match the roof angle and cemented to the roof, or you can cut a hole into the roof and the chimney placed into it.

Outhouse walls:

10A) Glue the four wall sections together as shown. Make sure the walls are square and set aside to dry.

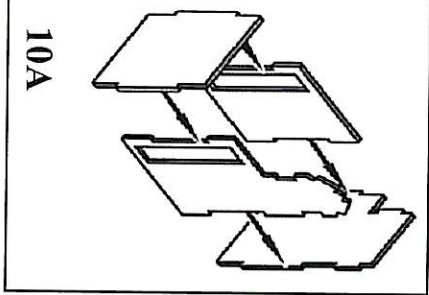
10B) Now add the two small upper wall sections to the outhouse.

10C) Apply the trim to the outhouse as shown. Next, assemble the two outhouse doors and insert them into the openings using the trim adhesive to hold them into place.

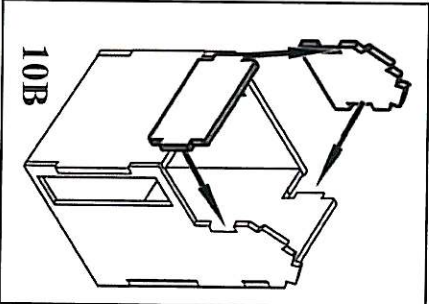
10D) Glue the subroof panels into place as shown.

10E) Add the roofing paper to the outhouse as you did with the station. A pre-cut section of roofing paper has been supplied for the flat section of the roof.

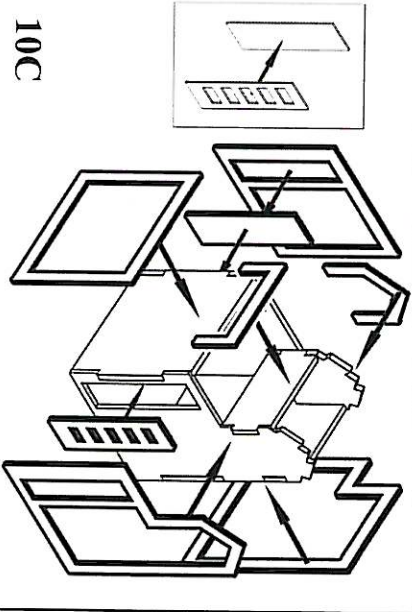
We have included some appropriate signs with the kit. Cut these off the sheet and glue into place where desired..



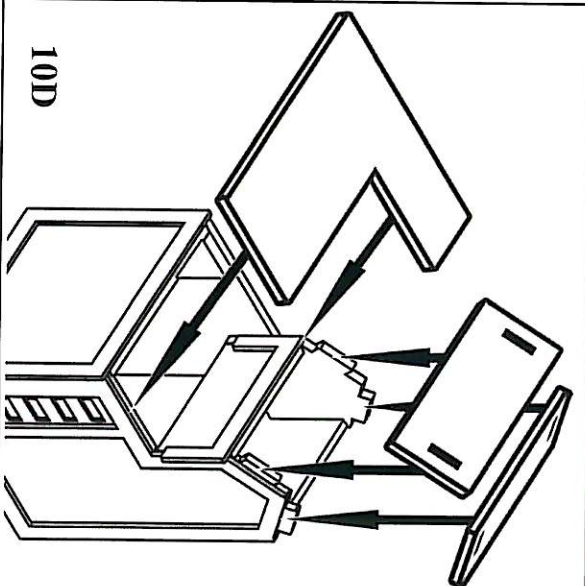

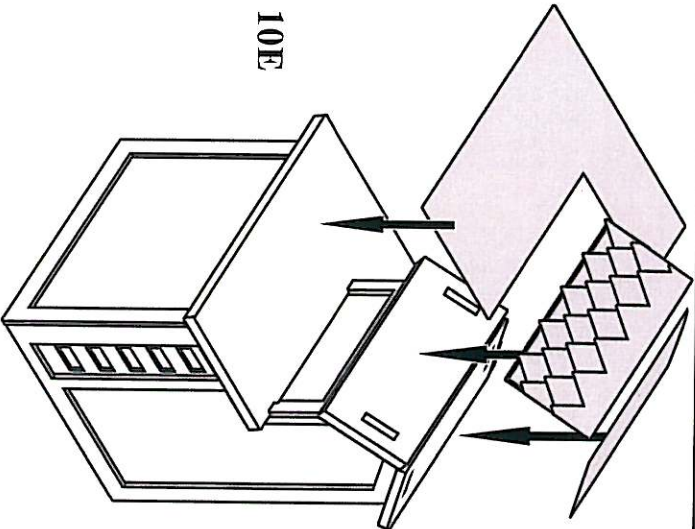
