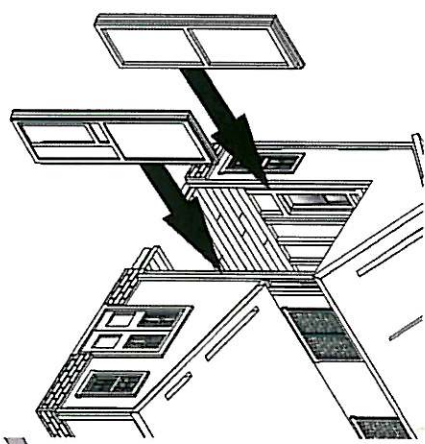
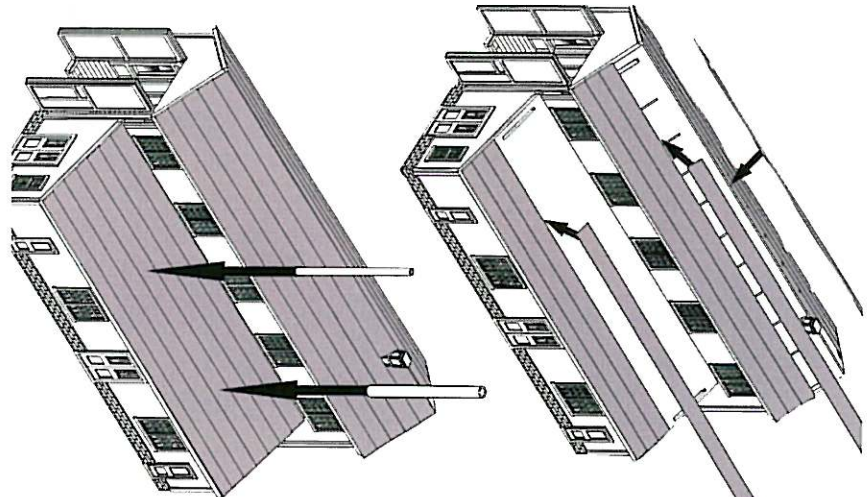


6B) Once your two doors are assembled, you can apply them in either an opened or closed position by sticking the exposed section of peel-and-stick on each door into the sides of the openings.

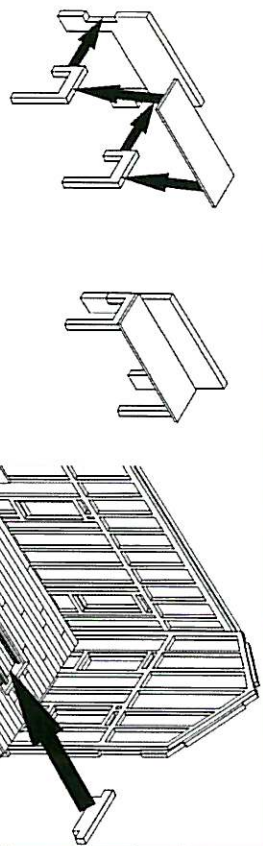


Tar paper roofing:

7A) A sheet of roofing is included with this kit. Remove the sections of tar paper roofing, starting at the bottom edges of the roofing, apply each strip of roofing with white glue, working your way up to the roof peaks. **NOTE:** Make sure you plan your spacing to ensure that you have enough tar paper to do the complete job. As a final touch take a tar paper strip, fold it in half longitudinally and apply it as a roof cap. Painting a small black stripe across the edges as well as down certain areas will give the effect of the roof being tar bonded together. You can also weather the roofing lightly with dry brushing as well.



7B) Two sizes of styrene tubing are supplied with this kit to represent the smoke stacks. Drill an appropriate sized hole into your roofing and place the chimney down through the roof. Secure with a bit of ACC. For added detail you can add some thread or fishing line (not included) guy wires to support the stacks.



Work benches and Flooring:

8A) A couple of workbenches have been added to this kit. Locate the rear of each bench and attach the left and right side legs. These will glue together in the notches provided. Remove the peel-and-stick backing from the bench tops and press into the tops of the legs.

8B) The flooring between the rails track boards is assembled by taking the peel-and-stick scribed boards and applying them to the small section of 1/16" plywood backing as shown. These two sections will glue onto the track sections at the front and rear of track in your engine house (See diagram for locations - Please note the track section is NOT included in the kit.)

We have included a small stop that can be placed at the end of the track by gluing it to the flooring.
