

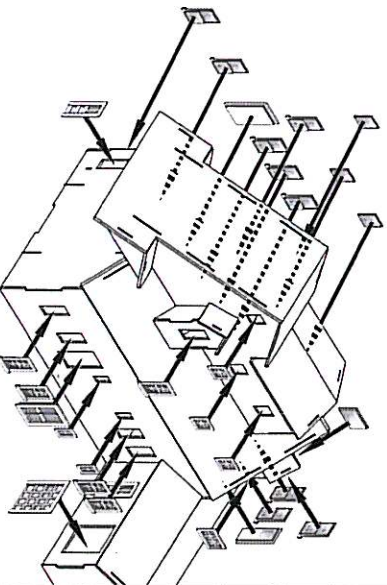
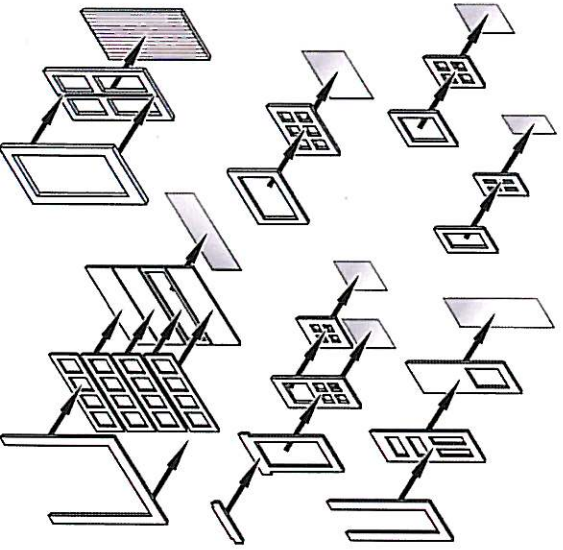
Roof dormers:

3) The two dormers are constructed in the same fashion. Glue the dormer side walls into the main structure walls, then glue the dormer front wall into place. The two sub roof panels can then be glued into place.

Windows and Doors:

It is easier to paint the various window, door and trim components while they are still on the sheet, so we recommend you do so before assembling the windows. Any visible edges can be touched up after installation.

4) To assemble the windows, first remove the peel-and-stick from the lower sash and apply a section of clear window glazing to it. Now do the same with the upper sash and frame making sure to keep the edge of the glazing flush with the top edge of the frame. Now stick the lower sash into place on the frame. Note that it is possible to position the lower sash in an open position if desired. Now take from it. Center the window sash assembly into the frame and press into place.



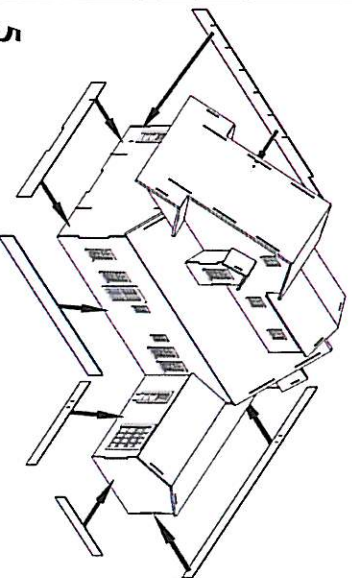
It is best to place the window assemblies into their openings as they are done. See diagram 4 for placement. The peel-and-stick on the frame will be enough to hold them into place.

The doors are built up from layers. Start by removing the backing from the inner door panel and applying the window glazing to it. (note that the loading dock door does not require glazing). Now apply the trim panel to the inner door panel. Finally, mount the outer frame section to the door, then insert the completed door into the wall opening.

Foundation:

5) Add the stone foundation sections by removing the peel-and-stick backing from each piece then pressing each into place at the bottoms of the appropriate wall.

Once in place you can paint the stonework with a gray or brown paint. Spend a few minutes and pick out some of the individual stones with lighter and darker shades of your base color. Once this is dry follow with a wash of light gray or black to represent the mortar between the stones (light gray will make the foundation appear newer, black older). Finally dry brush some light gray or tan highlights into the stones.
