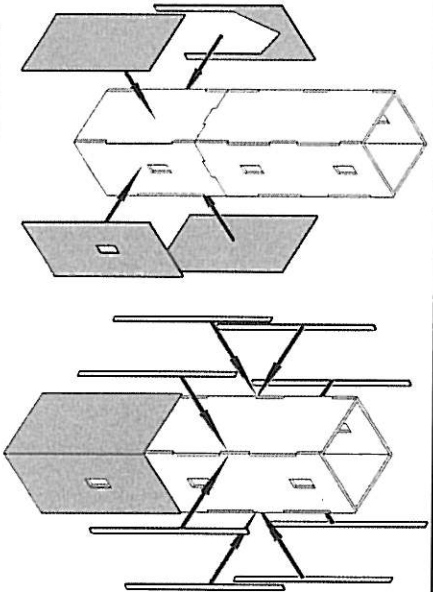


LASER-ART STRUCTURES by BRANCHLINE TRAINS



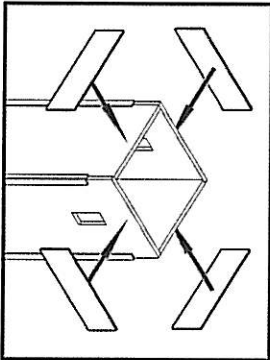
Tower foundation and trim work:

10A) Apply the stone foundation panels to the tower starting with the panel with the window opening and the opposite panel with the opening cut to fit over the roof of the house to tower connector. Now add the other two panels, overlapping at the corners as before. Touch up the corners as needed.

10B) Now apply the trim work to the side of the tower starting by applying the narrower boards flush with the edge of the wall, then overlapping the wider boards as before.

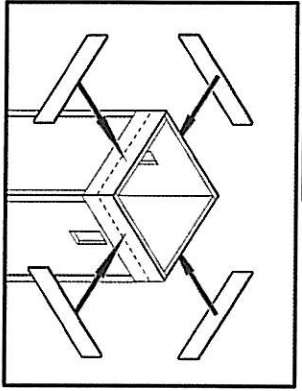
10C/D/E) Apply the three layer upper trim boards next. Start with the larger boards removing the backing from each one and applying it to the tower. Note that two of the boards will fit flush with the edges of the tower, the other two are slightly longer and overlap the first two you applied.

Apply the other two upper trim layers in the same way.



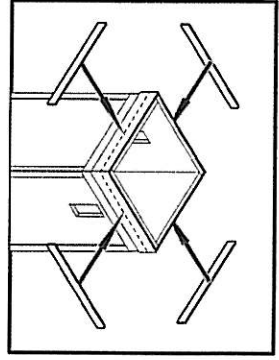
Tower windows:

11) Assemble the windows as you did the others. (Note that the tower windows have no inner sash). Install the completed windows as shown.

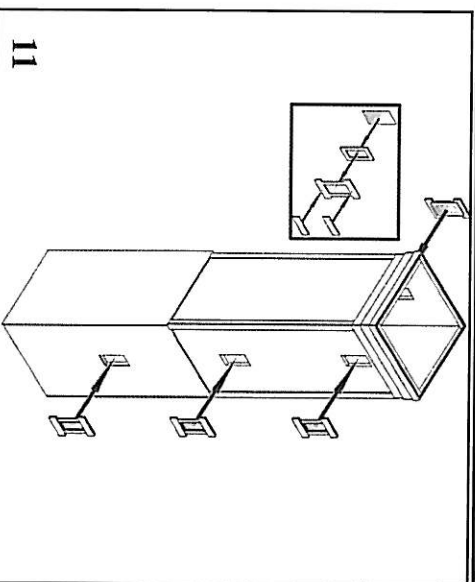


Tower to house connector:

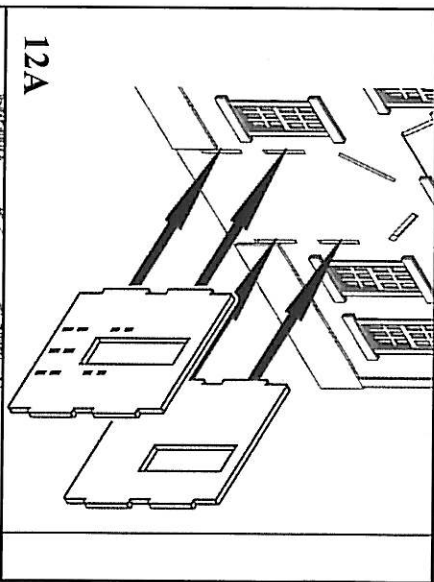
12A) Assemble the connecting walkway between the tower and the main house by gluing the two side wall assemblies into the slots in the house as shown. The wall with the door should face the same direction as the main door in the house, see diagram.



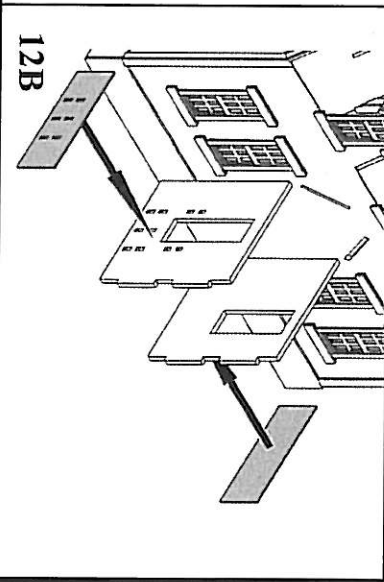
12B) Add the two sections of stone foundation to the lower sides of the wall sections.
