



15B) Glue the remaining porch railings into the slots in the side walls next to each door and to the steps themselves.

15C) Add the roofing over the front porch starting by first gluing smaller panel to the top of the railings, then gluing the larger onto the lower panel as shown.

Basement windows:

16) Assemble the basement windows by adding the clear glazing to the backside of the window sash then applying the outer trim. The window can then be pressed onto the back of the window frame. Install the completed windows to the front of the house as shown.

Tower top:

17) Glue the top platform onto the tower. Make sure the over hang is even on all four sides and allow to dry.

Paper roofing:

18) Apply the roofing shingles using white glue. Start at the bottom of each roof edge, gluing each strip of roof paper overlapping the previous row as you go up and staggering the joints between shingles as shown. You will need to cover the entire roof, window dormers and the overhang on the front porch.

The completed shingles can then be painted and weathered as desired. We like to use a slate gray paint and dry brush lighter shades of color to pick up the highlights.
